



Aspley State School (Amateur) Swimming Club and its members are excited to celebrate its 59th Season in 2025-2026.

The continuing aims of the Club are to:

- encourage self-improvement,
- promote good sportsmanship,
- encourage water confidence and fitness
- promote swimming as a competitive sport.

Our club operates from the Aspley State School pool between October and April each year. We welcome members from all schools in the area, both primary and secondary.

Our first Meet for the season is usually held on the first Sunday in Term 4 and is an afternoon event. After this start to the season, Club nights are held on Friday evenings from 6pm, throughout Term 4 and Term 1. We run a BBQ and canteen for the whole family to enjoy.



Aspley Swimming Club (ASC) is not just about racing for first; rather, we encourage our swimmers to improve their own personal best times. Club nights allow our swimmers to experience how races are organised and the rules involved. Each week, members swim together based on a similar skill and time level, with each swimmer's race time uploaded to an app, so that parents and swimmers can see their improvement each week.

Only basic swimming skills are required to participate in Aspley Swimming Club. We accept children who are as young as Prep, who can swim 12.5m (half the pool) unaccompanied. We also have senior swimmers in the pool to cheer and provide encouragement and support (if required).

At ASC, swimmers are not expected to enter the pool diving from the blocks; if a swimmer prefers, they can start their race in the pool. Older children start Club nights at 25m and as their skills and times improve, they move up to 50m, 100m and longer events.

Swimmers nominate which strokes they wish to participate in. Most swimmers start with freestyle and once their confidence grows, they can nominate to add other strokes throughout the season.
