Dear Parent/Caregiver,

Your child/ren are continuing or beginning in the Instrumental Music Program. This program is an elective program and is subject to a Student Resource Scheme. The Student Resource Scheme is voluntary to join. However, as this program is an elective, failure to join the Scheme will result in the withdrawal of your child from this program.

It is a requirement that every child in the Instrumental Music Program pays a charge of **\$40** per student per year (regardless of how many instruments learnt) and **\$80** per *school loan instrument*. If you are using your own instrument in this program, you do not pay the \$80 instrument loan charge. However, the \$40 charge must be paid. Please note that due to the nature of the program and the requirement for returned school instruments to be serviced, regardless of the length of time in the program, these charges are **NON – REFUNDABLE**.

The school Instrumental Music Program is an extension (elective) program. All lessons are free of charge, however the Student Resource Scheme is used to help fund associated, recurring costs in operating and maintaining the Program including: band music, instrument acquisition, upgrade and maintenance, equipment used by instrumental students, band folders etc. Some additional incidental costs may be involved. These costs are kept to a minimum. It is worthwhile noting that the cost of one private lesson exceeds the amount of the annual Instrumental Resource Scheme.

To pay for the Instrumental Music Student Resource Scheme, please **complete the attached Participation Agreement Form**, including preferred payment option, and return it to the school office as soon as possible. (Please note: Centrelink Deduction is NOT available). If paying by credit card, please complete the payment details section at the bottom of the second page of the Agreement Form. Payments made by cash, cheque or credit card can be sent to the school with this form. If you wish to pay by EFT, the school will generate an invoice on receipt of your Participation Agreement Form. This invoice will provide the payment reference number to be used.

Full payment is required by Friday 14 March 2014. The option of paying in instalments is not available for this program.

Failure to make this payment will result in the withdrawal of your child from this program. We value your support and with it, we look forward to your student enjoying, and achieving success in the program.
