1. Previous Minutes and Business Arising

- Previous minutes were accepted.
- Leann Griffith-Baker has been appointed the substantive principal of Aspley State School.

2. Principals Report

- Principal has recently attended the Independent Public Schools meeting of 180 schools.
- High School transition dates have been established.
- The school has linked to Apple allowing professional development
- The *Community Hire Agreement* has been completed and forwarded to the P&C Assoc.
- Staff are attending multiple professional development opportunities
- Work is occurring on both the netball courts and the school pool.

3. Project Reports

- Head of Curriculum presented NAPLAN Data to the School Council, discussing the Upper 2 Bands and the National Minimum Standards achieved in 2015.

4. School Council Election

- Sharon Rodgers is concluding her second year on the Council, with Craig Spink continuing for his third year.
- Nelma Wright is concluding her second year on the Council, with Lynne Rossiter continuing for her third year.
- Parent elections will be held prior to the P&C meeting on August 16th, with Staff elections occurring at the staff meeting in Week 5, 8 August 2016.

5. Education Adjustment Program Validation

- Principal discussed the process of adjustments so that students can access the curriculum and how adjustments are documented, and how this process is reviewed.

6. Student Support Team

- Report on the Student Support Team which was presented and discussed.

7. Powerful Learning

- Ian Craig started the Powerful Learning program. Aspley State School are adopting the coaching part of this program to support quality teaching.

8. Architecture

- The architecture plan presented to the P&C Assoc. by Scott Smith was discussed.

9. Partnerships Project

- It was discussed the commencement of the Partnerships Project, which has begun this term.

10. General Business

- It was recommended that School Council should meet prior to the P&C meeting, so that reports can be shared. Approved.
